

"Science meets Art" is chosen as this year's theme to explore the intersections of two seemingly different disciplines. During the 90-minute convention, we are planning on the following agenda:



Lisa Lu is a Chinese-born American actressand singer.

In 1960, she was the female lead in the antiwar film The Mountain Road, whichstarred James Stewart and which was based on the novel of the same name by the China war correspondent Theodore H. White. Herfilm career took off in the 1970s with supporting roles in films like Demon Seed and Peter Bogdanovich's Saint Jack. Duringthis time, she received three Best Actress Golden Horse Awards for her Chinese-language films *The Arch, The Empress Dowager,* and *The Fourteen Amazons*.

For the remainder of her career, Lu alternated betweentheater and film. She may be best known by English-speaking audiences for herroles in the 1988 TV miniseries Noble House, and the films The Last Emperor (1987), The Joy Luck Club (1993), and Crazy Rich Asians (2018).
